

Graduated licensing law



SUMMARY (law effective 7-1-2001)

To get an intermediate license, you must:

- 1 Be 16.
- 2 Have possessed a learner's permit for six months.
- 3 Have passed a driver's education course.
- 4 Have driven at least 50 hours (10 at night) while supervised by a driver 21+ years old.
- 5 Have passed a driver's test.
- 6 Have no traffic violations within the past six months before applying for an intermediate license.
- 7 Have no alcohol or drug offenses during the learner's permit period.

After getting an intermediate license:

- 1 First six months – no passengers under age 20, except immediate family.
- 2 After six months – up to three passengers under 20 who are not members of immediate family.
- 3 May not drive between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. unless with parent, guardian, or licensed driver over 25.

Restrictions end if:

- 1 You go 12 months with no accidents and no moving violations; or
- 2 You turn 18.
